Regulations

amending Finansinspektionen's regulations and general guidelines (FFFS 2019:22) regarding supervisory reporting for institutions for occupational pension retirement provision;

decided on 18 December 2024.

Finansinspektionen prescribes pursuant to Chapter 5, section 2, point 28 of the Occupational Pension Undertakings Ordinance (2019:809) that a new section, Chapter 1, section 3, shall be inserted into Finansinspektionen's regulations and general guidelines (FFFS 2019:22) regarding supervisory reporting for institutions for occupational pension retirement provision with the following wording.

Chapter 1

Section 3 The provisions set out in Chapter 3 do not apply to the reporting of ICT-related incidents pursuant to Article 19 of Regulation (EU) 2022/2554 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 December 2022 on digital operational resilience for the financial sector and amending Regulations (EC) No 1060/2009, (EU) No 648/2012, (EU) No 600/2014, (EU) No 909/2014 and (EU) 2016/1011.

These regulations shall enter into force on 17 January 2025.
